

Natural Horsemanship Workshops at Blue Cloud Farms



Natural Horsemanship is working with horses in their natural language of body movements, loyalty to their herd, and boundaries between members. When working with horses, we can overcome fear and find the balance of respect and communication. In our natural horsemanship workshops, we work to overcome obstacles, build confidence, and promote problem solving skills between you and your horse.

Workshops include small herd observation, discussions on natural horse behavior, basic games for ground work, challenging problem solving skills and tools to use with horses. Workshops are Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday.

(Although this workshop is targeted for current equestrians who are interested in learning more about horses and skills they can use to further improve their relationship with horses, we are open to those who know nothing of horses and are interested in attending our workshops.)

There are several types of workshops; little horse people (ages 8-13), teens (13 to 18) and adults (18+) Workshops are limited to six people and start Friday afternoon and go through Sunday afternoon. Snacks and tea will be provided but please bring a lunch. You can bring your own horse or play with one of ours. Cost is \$150 a workshop

Adult workshops are from 6/3 to 6/5, and a second one from 7/29 to 7/31

Teen workshop is from 6/24 to 6/26

Little horse people is from 7/8 to 7/10
